- Must be able to attend a minimum of 100 hrs of hands-on mentorship on the farm site.
- Must attend Educational Training with partners.

Series of on-line training will be given as programming enters into production and marketing stages that will include access to new markets..

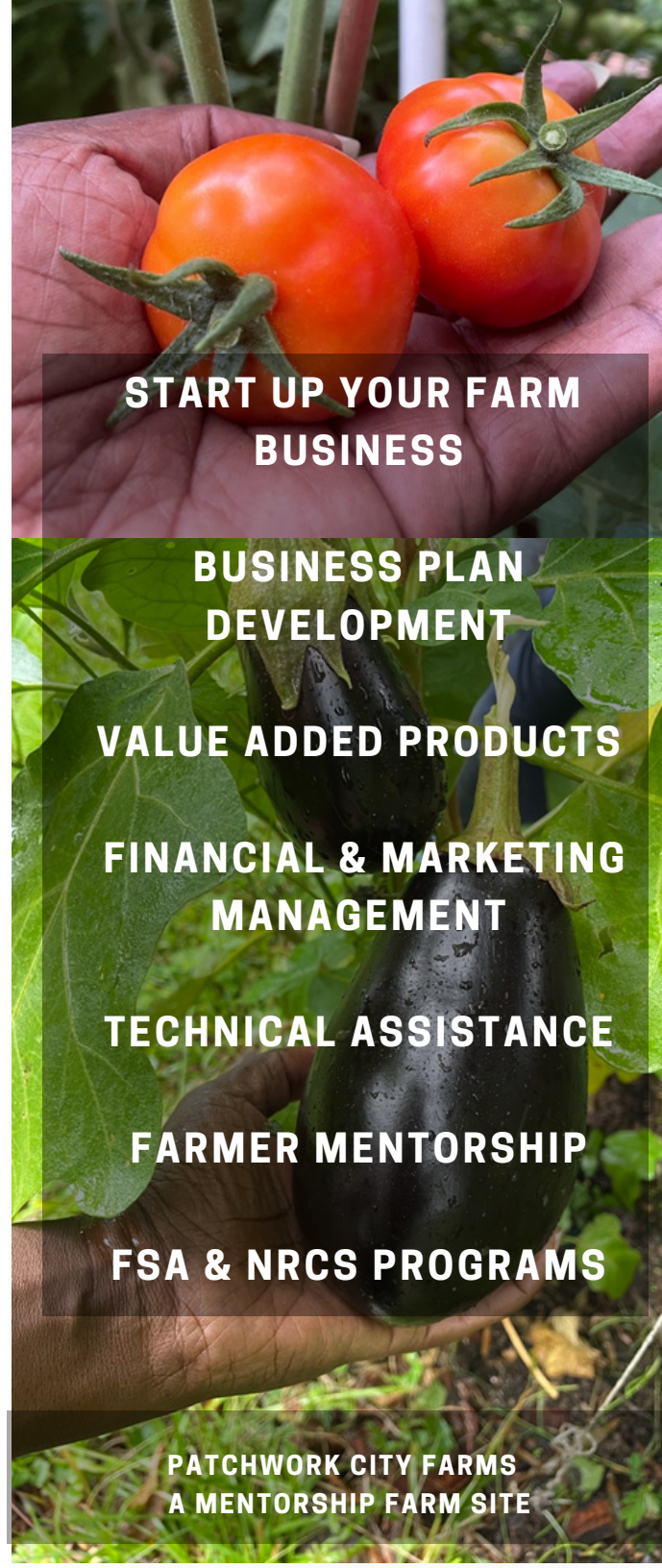
